Attendees will enjoy traditional picnic fare, prepared and donated by members of the participating organizations. Admission will be free and the event is open to the public.

Municipal candidates from the participating towns will be in attendance. The invitation has also been extended to the For Woodbury 2011 candidates, as well as to unaffiliated voters and their families. The picnic provides an opportunity for citizens to meet the candidates and for candidates to learn about the concerns of voters, concerns that are shared by all the towns in the area.

Ms. Peters encouraged voters to attend: 'For the past few years, we've invited the area Democrats to join Woodbury Democrats in a fall picnic to share our common goals'. Last year's picnic attracted over 220 participants, and featured the Democratic candidates for Federal, State, and local offices.
