**6<sup>th</sup> Annual Washington, D.C. High School Student Internship Program**

The Woodbury Democratic Town Committee Consortium of the 32<sup>nd</sup> State Senate District is pleased to invite interested 32<sup>nd</sup> District students who will be entering their senior or junior year of high school in fall 2012 to apply for a Washington, D.C. Internship Program to be held June 26 through June 29, 2012. The 32<sup>nd</sup> State Senate District includes the towns of Bethlehem, Bridgewater, Middlebury, Oxford, Roxbury, Seymour, Southbury, Washington, Watertown, and Woodbury. Participating Democratic Town Committees may support the students by providing partial funding. The participating students will pay for their transportation and the unfunded portion of the trip accommodations.
